


Village of Red Hook
Workshop Meeting
June 17, 2010
7:15

Present: DM Blundell, Trustee Trapp, Trustee Kovalchik

1. **Parking Lot Striping** – 3 estimates were submitted – Easy Street \$ 425.00, Top Quality Seal Coat \$ 700.00, Zebra Striping \$ 350.00. Parking lot must be ADA compliant. Prices include removal of old lines. Trustee Kovalchik made a motion to go with East Street for \$ 425.00. Approval is contingent that they consult with ADA Coordinator Sam Harkins on where the handicap spaces should go and the proper configuration of the spaces.. Trustee Trapp seconded. All were in favor.
2. **Resolution # 7-2010** – transfer \$ 5000.00 from 2770 to 1440.4. These funds assist the Village of Red Hook to reimburse expenses used to provide engineering services for the Sate Routes to School project. DM Blundell made this in the form of a motion.
3. **Zero Turn Lawn Mower** – no bids were submitted – Clerk Cole was advised to resubmit to the paper another ad to sell the old zero turn. Bids will be due on 7-6 and opened at the July 12th board meeting. Trustee Trapp asked the Clerk to check with the NYCOM if it is legal to sell or purchase from Craig's list.
4. **Cambridge Drive** – 3 estimates were submitted to repair 2 catch basins on Cambridge Drive. A. W. Coon \$ 1,445.00, Frank Vosburgh \$ 1,550.00. Clerk Cole called Pete Coon to request if the bid included blacktop. Mr. Coon advised that the Village provides the blacktop. Trustee Kovalchik made a motion to accept the bid from Vosburgh due to the fact that it is more complete. Trustee Trapp seconded. All were in favor. This will be paid by CHIPS. Also a 2 million dollar insurance certificate must be on file.
5. **Cherry Street & East Market Street-** Parking in front of the Mercato's Restaurant is in compliance with signs at the intersection of Cherry Street and East Market St. but there is discussion of sight lines to the east when a large vehicle is parked on East Market and Cherry, east of the corner. Speed limit is 30 mph here. The village wants to promote the success of local business but needs safe traffic flow in the area. Trustee Kovalchik has spoken to Nick Haddad of Red Hook Electric and they discussed allowing patrons of the restaurant to use the store's parking lot evenings and weekends. Trustee Trapp stated an option is to send a letter drafted to Mercato's Restaurant explaining the concern at this intersection and asking them to meet with Mr. Haddad to discuss an agreement to develop off-street options. The Village should get involved as facilitator but the agreement should be between the two store owners. Trustee Blundell will draft this letter.
6. **Zoning Map Revisions** – A map was submitted for the boards review on zoning revisions of certain properties. We are still in the public hearing time frame. The Board is in agreement of these revisions. SEQRA must be circulated within 30 days. Village Clerk will advertise that we are still open with the public hearing and will close in July. Trustee Trapp will draft a letter for all residents involved.
7. **DM Blundell** will read a proclamation at an event for the Big Read at the Elmendorph this weekend.

DM Blundell made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Trustee Trapp seconded. All were in favor.
