Public Hearing of CDBG-CV Cares Grant

Supervisor McKeon opened the public hearing at 7:35 pm.

Supervisor McKeon explained the grant request changes. Due to availability, The Town will be submitting an application to the Farmworkers Housing Grant only.

Supervisor McKeon began the discussion by explaining the grant request.

Some of the projects include weatherizing and improving air quality conditions at Mead Orchards, replacing a mobile home and repairs to a farm labor house at Rose Hill Farm, upgrading substandard utilities and repairs at farm employee housing at Greig Farm as well as projects at Migliorelli Farm and Sun Runner Farm.

\$50,000.00 is also allocated for a Project Manager to administer the grant.
